MAROUSSIA ROMANOFF - The Final Farewell







It was with great sadness that we said a final farewell to Maroussia on Friday 23rd February, as her ashes were interred next to her beloved partner Pieter at the cimetière at Moissaguel on a bright cold afternoon. Around a dozen French, British and Dutch club members were there to pay their respects to this amazing lady, founder of the Club International du Quercy almost 25 years earlier. A bowl of flowering plants was given in the Club's name, which will be planted around the grave in due course.

Our immense gratitude goes to Maroussia, whose inspiration all those years ago means that we have the thriving International Club that we all enjoy today.

The idea must have been born around 1993, when Maroussia was running a French conversation class in a room over the Mairie. That year there was an outing on the Lot, in 1994 a shared venue was offered and the Club was open once a month, and by 1995 there were gatherings 3 times a week, and thirty members. Maroussia was president from the beginning until she had to retire for personal reasons in 2001. During that time, she created a monthly newsletter, La Feuille, there were many of the activities still at the heart of the club today, outings, voyages, meals, randonnées, language classes, scrabble, dance, and of course Saturday coffee, which even then struggled to find volunteers to serve it! Some things never change.....

The original Club met at various locations in Montaigu until it finally moved to the present premises in the autumn of 2000. Maroussia was able to return to the Club after a while, and has been a constant presence on Saturdays until very recently when her health began to fail. Tea was her favourite beverage, and we always served it to her in a tiny pink teapot, which now resides in the pottery display cabinet as a memorial to her. She will be sorely missed by many friends old and new.

This is just a glimpse of her life in the Club, but if you want to browse further, the club archives, which were carefully compiled by Genevieve at the time of the 20th anniversary, make fascinating reading. Just ask a member of the comité to dig them out of the store cupboard on a Saturday morning.

Périgueux - Wednesday, 25 April

Come and visit the delightful city of Périgueux by train. The train departs Penne d'Agenais Station for the interesting train ride through woods, villages and hopefully seeing their gardens in spring bloom.

The name Périgueux comes from Petrocorii, a Latinization of Celtic words meaning "the four tribes" - the Gallic people that held the area before the Roman conquest. Périgueux was their capital city. In 200 BC, the Petrocorii came from the north and settled at Périqueux and established an encampment at La Boissière. After the Roman invasion, they left this post and established themselves on the plain of L'Isle, and the town of Vesunna was created. This Roman city was eventually embellished with amenities such as temples, baths, amphitheatres, and a forum. At the end of the third century AD, the Roman city was surrounded by ramparts, and the town took the name of Civitas Petrocoriorum.

The journey takes just under two hours in a comfortable carriage with toilets on board.


